7th Grade

Title/Text: "Is That Your Final Answer?" (Matt. 19:16-26)

Lesson: Youth will learn that nothing in life is more important or more valuable than following Christ.

Home Connect: Re-read the passage together, then discuss the priority of FOLLOWING CHRIST (not just 'praying to receive Him') should have in our life.

8th Grade Girls

**Currently studying through the Bible in 2 yrs.: Genesis to Revelation-They are in yr. 1*

Title/Text: "David and Goliath" (1 Sam. 17:1-52)

Lesson: Youth will learn that God will give us the ability to face even our toughest challenges.

Home Connect: Take time to reread the passages together, discussing how we are stand against the schemes of the devil and how God will provide what we need to fight that battle (can tie into Paul's talk on spiritual warfare in Eph. 6:10ff)

8th-9th Grade Boys & 9th Grade Girls

**Currently studying through the Bible in 2 yrs.: Genesis to Revelation-They are in yr. 2*

Title/Text: "Arrest and Trial" (Matt. 26:47-27:26)

Lesson: Youth will learn Jesus showed courage during His trial, while friends and accusers alike showed cowardice.

Home Connect: Take time to reread the passage together, discussing the events leading up to the crucifixion, how Jesus reacted, and how His followers reacted. "How do you think Jesus felt when that happened?" "Do you think He feels the same when we sin/turn against Him in our actions?"

10th-12th Grade Boys & 10th-11th Grade Girls

**Currently studying through a 2 yr. theology/world religions curriculum-They are in yr. 2*

Title/Text: "Spiritual Warfare" (Acts 26:17-18; Eph 1:20-23; 2:6; 6:10-18; Heb. 2:14-18; 1 John 3:8)

Lesson: Youth will learn Christians have been given the authority and power through Jesus Christ to stand against the temptations and schemes of the devil.

Home Connect: Reread the passages with your youth, asking "How can someone stand against the power and schemes of Satan?" (The forces of evil are very methodical and clever-how are we to stand against them?)

12th Grade Girls

**Currently studying through Alex McFarland's The 10 Most Common Objections to Christianity*

Discuss with your youth the objection they discussed this week using the book.
